- Square footage increased to 125,800 from 97,000
- Baggage capacity increased to 7,000-plus bags
- 68 general ticket counter stations with four VIP
- Five security lanes
- Updates completed: November 2016

Updated Cruise Terminal 5

- \$48 million total project
- \$18 million in terminal renovations
- Capacity increased to handle 3,500-passenger ships, up from 2,500

Other upgrades –

- 70 general ticket counter stations

- New \$4 million waterside improvements
- New \$18 million 1,044-space parking garage
- Updates completed: June 2016
